- Four person teams
- No roster changes after deadline
- Double elimination format
- Divisions are determined by age, height, and weight, beginning with players entering the fifth grade through adult
- No division based on sex. Male and female teams will compete together
 - 1st place team and individual trophies
 - 2nd place team trophy
- All players will receive a souvenir

Tournament Rules & Regulations

1. Games go to 20 for all Junior High School and up teams. A team must win by 2, or first to 25.
2. Elementary grade (through 6th grade) team games go to 15 points straight up.
3. Please note that games may be shortened, or a time limit imposed, in the event of unexpected delays.
4. Baskets are 1 point each. The 2 point line will be in effect.
5. Ball must be taken back after each change of possession.
6. Players call their own fouls and violations. On some courts, extra tournament officials may be assigned.
7. Players may only play on one team.
8. A player cannot play with a cast or splint of any kind.
9. No slam dunking!
10. Flagrant fouls or intentional fouls will be considered technical fouls.
11. The penalty for a technical foul is the opposing team will get 2 free throws, using the player of their choice to shoot, plus retain possession of the ball.
12. Abusive or foul language and/or behavior by a player, coach, or team supporter will also be considered technical fouls.
13. No unsportsmanlike conduct is allowed - NO WARNINGS - the offender will be ejected from the game. If a player, coach, or manager is ejected from a game, he/she will not be allowed to participate in any capacity in the next game his/her team plays.
14. No alcoholic beverages are allowed anywhere in the tournament area.
15. In jump ball situations, alternate possession will be used, starting with the team that was on defense at the start of the game.

Barnyard Classic Information (cont'd)

16. A team is allowed one time-out per game. An injury time-out doesn't count - substitute your extra player and keep going.
17. All courts will have at least one tournament official to keep score and oversee the games.

TO ENTER

- Complete the application on the first page for each player
- Each player must read and sign the waiver of liability on page two of the application. Players under 18 must have waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian
- Medical treatment release form must also be signed by a parent or legal guardian for all players under 18 (forms available at sign in)
